## Nuclear forum once again in Prague

On 29<sup>th</sup> May, the fourth European Nuclear Energy Forum will be held at the Prague Congress Centre. The forum was created in 2007 as a platform for discussion about the opportunities and risks, which the use of nuclear energy brings. The Nuclear Forum is held by the European Commission in cooperation with the Czech and Slovak governments.

The participants of the forum will include leading political representatives of many member states, the representatives of EU institutions, representatives of power companies and also consumer and non-governmental organisations. The Prime Minister of the Czech Republic, under the official aegis of whom the forum is being held, will speak at the European Nuclear Energy Forum. The prime ministers of Slovakia, Poland, Estonia and other states are also expected to attend.

The European Nuclear Forum is intended to serve as an advisory body for institutions of the EU in fields such as ensuring the security of electricity supplies, investment support, research and development in energy and in matters of EU legislation. The aim of the nuclear forum is also to stimulate a public debate on the use of nuclear energy.

The press conference will be held on 29<sup>th</sup> May from 09:45 in the Congress Centre Prague. For the duration of the European Nuclear Energy Forum a press centre will be open with direct audiovisual transmission of the proceedings. The press department of the Ministry of Industry and Trade is responsible for the accreditation of journalists.
